Biographical or Historical Note

Donald B. White (1936-1995) was a Roswell native. He served as a Roswell City Councilman from 1967-1995. He was active in local historic preservation, zoning, and parks. White was a chairperson of the Roswell Parks and Recreation Committee and Volunteer Fire and Rescue Department. White passed away while still serving as a councilman and his seat was taken by his wife, Sally White, whose actions continued Don's work in the interest of Roswell parks.
