**Biographical or Historical Note**

The Roswell Woman's Club was organized in the spring of 1948 by a group of women from Roswell, Georgia as an all-volunteer, and non-profit service organization.

The Club was inactive from 1960 to 1965. By spring of 1965, a small group of ladies, including some members of the former RWC, met to organize another club. During the first few years of operation, the growth in the area was too limited to warrant federating the club. As a result, the club never had a national affiliation, and the efforts of the Club have focused exclusively on local issues and the betterment of the Roswell community.

The Roswell Fine Arts Alliance and the Roswell Historical Society are offshoots of the organization.

## **Scope and Content**

The collection contains recorded minutes of Roswell Woman's Club meetings. It also holds printed materials relating to the club, such as its handbooks.
