Biographical or Historical Note

James D. Mosteller (1854-1933) was a farmer from the Little River District of Milton County (near Crabapple). He was married to Arena Josephine Rainwater (1856-1936). In the mid-1920s, the Mostellers moved into Roswell, living at a home on Canton Street. Listed in the 1840 Roswell census, the Mosteller family is among the earliest families to settle in the Roswell area.

William Harve Earley (W. H. Earley) (1884-1968) was a farmer from the Little River District and the husband of Myrta Mosteller (1879-1923). Myrta was the daughter of J. D. Mosteller. After going bankrupt in 1929, Earley and his two children lived with J. D. and Arena Mosteller at their Canton Street house.

The Mosteller family papers include land grants, deeds, promissory notes, receipts, estate papers, and correspondence.
