Biographical or Historical Note

James Dunwody Bulloch (1823-1901) was a naval agent of the Confederate States based in Liverpool, England during the Civil War. He procured ships and equipment for the Confederate Navy, most famously the CSS *Alabama*. Bulloch was not granted amnesty after the Civil War and remained in Liverpool until his death.

Bulloch was the son of James Stephens Bulloch and Martha Elliot Stewart Bulloch, members of one of the founding families of Roswell, Georgia. He is also the half-brother of Martha "Mittie" Bulloch Roosevelt (1835-1884), mother of Theodore Roosevelt (1858-1919).

Scope and Content

The James Dunwody Bulloch Collection contains research and correspondence pertaining to the status of Bulloch's gravesite and his life after the Civil War in Liverpool, England. It also contains photographs of Bulloch's gravesite. This collection was assembled by Janine Powers and Darlene Walsh.
