Biographical or Historical Note

George H. Camp (1817-1907) was an early resident of Roswell associated with the Roswell Manufacturing Company. Born in New York, Camp took an offer from his cousin, Henry Merrell, to work at the Roswell Manufacturing Company. Camp boarded with the King family and became especially close with Barrington King. He became King's assistant at the Roswell Manufacturing Company. Camp continued to oversee production during the Civil War until the Mills were burned by Union troops. Following the war and the death of Barrington King, Camp became president of the Roswell Manufacturing Company. Camp rebuilt the company and served as its president until he resigned in 1867.
