Biographical or Historical Note

George "Georgie" King Camp (1851-1899) was the son of George Hull Camp and Jane Atwood Camp. George H. Camp was Barrington King's assistant agent at the Roswell Manufacturing Company. Following the Civil War and the death of Barrington King, he became president of the Roswell Manufacturing Company until he resigned in 1867.

George King Camp was born in Darien, Georgia and spent his childhood in Cobb County, Georgia. He attended the University of Georgia, graduated with honors from the Virginia Military Institute, and studied law in Albany, New York. He published two volumes of poetry. He set to music James Barron Hope's poetry. Hope (1829-1887) was a one-time poet laureate of Virginia.
