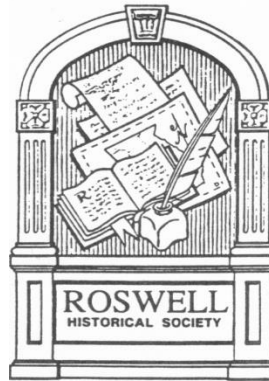

Biographical or Historical Note

Charles E. Abercrombie served as the Mayor of Roswell from 1957-1962. Abercrombie succeeded T.W. "Ford" Rucker (1950-1957) and preceded Aubrey E. Greenway (1963-1966) as Roswell's mayor. Highlights of Abercrombie's administration included bringing natural gas to Roswell, paving major streets, the construction of a one half-million-gallon water tank, and an increase in city revenue.

Scope and Content

This collection holds the papers of the Honorable Charles E. Abercrombie from 1950 to 1961. These papers include correspondence, a letterhead, an ordinance, printed programs, and newspaper clippings. The collection also contains a scrapbook which includes photographs and events on Roswell during the 1950s.
