Biographical or Historical Note

Bulloch Hall Archaeological Society (BHAS) was a chapter of the Society of Georgia Archaeological Society, a non-profit organization whose vision is “that all Georgians understand the significance of their archaeological sites so that they will support preservation, education and research.” BHAS met in the “Cottage” at Bulloch Hall, Roswell (Ga.) on the third Thursday of the month. The chapter was in existence from 1994 to 2008.
